Moss project grows on inmates at Wash. prison

Who says prison is no fun? Prisoners at one facility have [completed research](#) on slow-growing mosses. The "Moss-in-Prisons" project at Cedar Creek Corrections Center in Littlerock, Washington, is funded by the National Science Foundation.

"I need help from people who have long periods of time available to observe and measure the growing mosses; access to extensive space to lay out flats of plants; and fresh minds to put forward innovative solutions," says project head researcher Nalini Nadkarni of Evergreen State College in a statement. One former inmate has started graduate studies in microbiology after participating in the research.
